Our own Buddy Sullivan will be debuting his new program, "The Naval War of 1812." In commemoration of America's oft-forgotten war with Great Britain, this illustrated lecture will feature the U.S. Navy of the early republic and relate the traditions of the fledgling service that were established by its series of encounters with the powerful Royal Navy on the high seas and the Great Lakes during the War of 1812. There will be a strong Georgia component to the lecture relating to the cutting of coastal live oak to build the early frigates of the Navy and the large number of towns and counties named in Georgia in honor of the naval heroes of the war.

Buddy Sullivan is the author of 17 books on coastal Georgia history, specializing in antebellum agriculture and the maritime heritage of the tidewater. Since his retirement a year ago, he stays constantly busy teaching and lecturing on all aspects of Georgia history.

Please consider this thoughtfully when you are contacted. The Committee will make their report in April, elections are held in May, and those selected will assume their jobs in June.

• The Board of Directors feel the By-Laws need to be amended in order for there to be a smoother transition of officers each year. We do need staggered terms for continuity so that all officers do not rotate off in the same year but we need to have the President and the Vice-President elected in the same year, which would mean the Secretary and Treasurer would be elected the following year. The sentence denoting this is the only change being made to Section 2. Thus, the Board proposes that the section on election of officers should read as follows: Article IV Officers, Section 2, "At the annual meeting in May each year, the officers shall be elected by the membership from the list of members in good standing. The term of each officer shall be for two (2) years and until a successor is designated. The terms will be staggered, with a President and a Vice-President being elected in the even

numbered years, and a Secretary and a Treasurer being elected in the odd numbered years. Each of said officers shall serve as and have all powers and privileges of a director during their respective terms of office. In the event a vacancy occurs, the Board of Directors, by majority vote, shall fill the vacancy for the unexpired term."

The Board has designated our March 2014 meeting as a "special meeting in order to vote on this amendment so that it will be in effect when our elections take place during our Annual Meeting in May 2014.
