"A Legacy Drawn in Maps: The Story of John C. Fremont" will be the subject of this month's program. Georgia Historical Society Education Coordinator Sophia Sineath will be our guest speaker. Focusing on the Georgia Historical Festival's 2013 featured historical character, John C. Fremont, the presentation will examine Fremont's adventures in the American West, exploring the lasting impacts of his three most famous western expeditions from 1842-1846.

John Charles Fremont was born in Savannah, GA in January 1813, and had an interesting and varied career – from being a mathematics instructor for the US Navy to serving as California Senator to running unsuccessfully as the first Republican candidate for President of the United States in 1856. He died in New York City in 1890.

Kevin Kiernan will be presenting "Archaeology on the Lower Altamaha: The Elizafield and Evelyn Presentation Sites." He will focus on the tabby ruins on those two sites, as well as the complex of Indian mounds at Evelyn.

Kevin Kiernan is Professor of English Emeritus, T. Marshall Hahn Sr. Professor of Arts and Sciences Emeritus, University of Kentucky. He received his PhD from Case Western Reserve University in 1970. He was on the Board of Directors, Society for Georgia Archaeology from 2008-2012 and also Chair of the Fall 2010 meeting of SGA, *"Historic Preservation of Prehistoric, Colonial and Plantation Structures on the Coast."* He has done extensive field work in the area and shared his knowledge of archaeology through several publications and numerous presentations throughout the South.

Mark Waters ("*Whatever Happened to the Confederate Gold?*") returns to present the "*Rest of the Story*" from his September 2012 program. The value of the Confederate treasury was estimated to be in the neighborhood of more than \$10 million in today's value. He will focus on what happened to it and what was accounted for and what was not.

Mark attended Duke University and the University of Georgia, and earned his PhD from UGA. He has published articles on the Confederate treasury and missing Virginia assets.
