LAHS Meeting, Thursday, May 19, 2016 Fort King George Historic Site Dutch treat supper, 5:45 p.m. at B&J Steak

Jo Hickson, Executive Director of the Georgia Coastal Greenway Project, will provide an overview of the trail initiative for LAHS members, particularly as it pertains to those portions of the bicycle trail in McIntosh and Glynn Counties. The Georgia component of the Greenway trail is a part of the overall east coast- to the - U.S. effort to establish a Greenway bike trail from Miami to south Florida.

Ms. Hickson received a Bachelor of Landscape Architecture in 1975 from UGA School of Environmental Design. She received the Georgia Planning Association Outstanding Document award in 2004. As a board member of the Coastal Georgia Land Trust, she was project manager for "The Gateway to Coastal Georgia: Connecting the Coast" Master Plan, a project that proposed a 450-mile greenway system in coastal Georgia. Since 1993 she has participated in development of a regional greenway in coastal Georgia. In working with public and private sectors to fund the trail, she has written grants totaling \$3.5 million public funding and \$20,000 in private funding. She has conducted 75 public meetings, developed brochures, a video and web page, and trail and interpretive signs for the ongoing project. In 2009, The Coastal Georgia Greenway, Inc., received IRS 501(c)(3) non-profit status and is incorporated in Georgia.

Sudy Leavy will provide a program about Hofwyl-Broadfield rice plantation on the Altamaha River, and will portray Miss Ophelia Dent. Miss Dent was the last private owner of Hofwyl who was directly descended from the early 19<sup>th</sup> century Brailsfords, Troups and Dents who owned the tract. A native of Griffin, Sudy lived on the Georgia coast for almost 50 years before moving to the red clay hills in 2013. Living in Athens has afforded her registry at UGA as a student, participation in a scientific study at the Ramsey Center, and access to the

incredible UGA libraries. With an A.B. and M.A. in English, she hopes to add a degree in Georgia history, her long-held passion which was originally kindled by her seventh grade teacher. In 2008, she authored *Hofwyl-Broadfield Plantation* under the Arcadia series. The gift of a 60-year correspondence of Ophelia Dent's and access to Savannah papers dealing with other members of the family have added depth to her study of Dent.
